

What to do in case of conflicts with your supervisor?

Conflicts among doctoral candidates and supervisors can often arise during a PhD. There are several different points of contact you can turn to in case you realize a conflict is arising. Often, it is helpful to search for advice on how to resolve a conflict BEFORE it escalates.

These are some of the points of contact you can turn to (details below):

- us your PhD reps;)
- Ombuds office: they can give you great advice to resolve your conflict situation, even when not starting an ombuds
 process
- Staff council of University or Uniclinics (see details below): Legal advice on employment rights and many more topics
- Legal counseling at SWFR and StuRa (if you're enrolled)
- For legal advice, you can turn to unions (e.g. DGB / GEW)
- As a last resort, if the other options did not help, you might want to turn to a lawyer

All PhD candidates who are registered at the Faculty of Biology form our PhD Convent.


We are your official representation!


The PhD Convent for Biology was established in 2016. For an overview what we achieved since then, have a look at our yearly reports, e.g. the one from 2018 or 2019.

- Joint Working Committee of the Doctoral Candidate Councils ("GAA"): monthly, Wednesdays at 6 pm




